I do hope you will decide to join us at this worthwhile fundraising event. All of the profits provide things for all of our pupils.



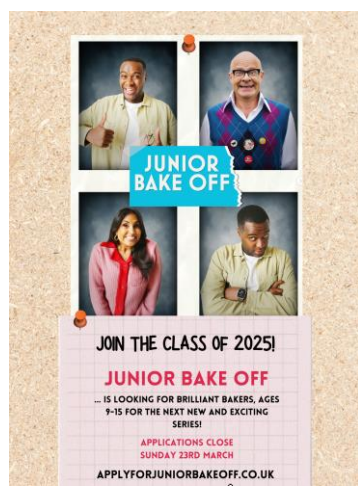
